Thank you for your E-mail dated May 9. I read it this morning sitting down in my armchair, as I attended the spring meeting of the West Japan Society of Naval Architects held in Shimonoseki and came back my home last night.

I am hurrying to reply to your questions as follows:

- (1) I have not undertaken a reanalysis of the ISI/DIS example using the Taniguchi-Tamura method.
- (2) The question concerning the misprint suspected by you was made in the E-mail towards Prof. Ikehata. It was my understanding that I did not be obliged to reply to you directly, since I got a copy of the above mail.
- I believe there are no misprint in my data. Would you please to point out the suspected part in detail, if you think there any.

I would like to stress that the analysis by use of Taniguchi-Tamura method was made based on these data without any trouble. Furthermore, I would like to stress that a data obtained in ship trails may contain much error due to measurements and disturbances in many kinds.
